Gospel Reading

John 14:23-29

Jesus promises his disciples that the Father will send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit.

This portion of John's Gospel comes near the end of the first of four chapters that make up Jesus' long farewell discourse at the Last Supper. This section of chapter 14 actually sums up the themes of the opening of the discourse: the Christian's life is not shaped by Jesus' absence but by God's abiding presence; God's presence overcomes anxiety about God's absence; and the present holds in it the seeds of a fresh future shaped by love, not fear.



These verses also contain a glimpse of some of the other themes of the farewell discourse: Jesus' relationship with the Father and the disciples' relationship to Jesus connect the disciples to the Father as well. Jesus promises to send an Advocate or intercessor who will remind the disciples of everything that Jesus taught them and bring them peace.

Jesus is preparing his disciples in advance for his absence so that they will continue to believe in him and not feel all alone after his return to the Father. After the initial excitement of his Easter appearances, Jesus will remain with his followers in a very different way throughout the centuries.

As our celebration of the Easter season is coming to an end, the liturgy reminds us that Jesus remains with us through the Holy Spirit, who teaches us everything we need to know, reminds us of all that Jesus taught, and brings us peace.

Special Collection: Pope's Pastoral Works – May 22, 2022

The Pope's Pastoral Works collection was established by the bishops of Canada in 1970. The Papal Charities allow the Pope to contribute to various charitable causes around the world, particularly toward aiding the victims of war, famine and natural disasters. By contributing to the Pope's Pastoral Works, the faithful of Canada give a universal dimension to their charity.

REPAIRS UPDATE:

CHIMNEY REPAIRS: During the fall of 2021 the existing boiler was replaced at Our Lady of Assumption Parish. This work involved the installation of a new exhaust flue. At the time of installation, the existing chimney was found to be in extremely poor condition and unsuitable for the flue installation. Larkin Architect Limited (LAL) was provided with photographs of the chimney and requested to co-ordinate its repair.

LAL conducted a site visit in January of 2022. The existing chimney could only be observed from the ground. Based on site photographs, the chimney appeared in extremely poor condition and LAL estimated approximately 25% of the chimney needed to be repointed, and 75% of the chimney needed to be rebuilt. Additionally, the capstone needs to be reset and proper flashing installed. Closer inspection and demolition could alter this scope positively or negatively.

Based on this general scope, LAL contacted several trades with the appropriate expertise and experience in the Diocese. Due to the lack of available trades LAL found it extremely difficult to get fixed price quotations. LAL contact five different trades and received two written quotations and one verbal quotation.

Quotations ranged from **\$110,00—\$140,000**. Of the quotations received, Roof Time Management Inc. (RTM) quote of \$114,175 represented good value. Additionally, RTM expressed the ability to start immediately.

We are given the approval by the chancery office to proceed with the repairs.

RAMPS REPAIRS: We are also on the process of fixing/replacing the existing concrete steps and ramps around the church as they do not meet the Ontario Building Code Standards or AODA standards. The estimate price for this project is \$250k. I will make a complete report to the community as soon as the information are available.
