Sunday Gospel Reflection....

Whoever does the will of God is brother and sister and mother to me (Mark 3:20–35)



In the section of the Gospel just before these verses, Jesus calls his Twelve Apostles. Now he performs his first exorcism. It is told within the context of conflict with his family.

A crowd so large has gathered that Jesus and his disciples are not even able to eat their bread. His family comes to take him away because they think he is beside

himself. And the scribes think he is possessed by the devil. Jesus points out to them the absurdity of their thinking that he uses the devil to cast out demons. In fact, it is Jesus who ties up the strong man, Beelzebub, and overcomes him.

He concludes with a brief saying about the forgiveness of sins. All sin can be forgiven except for blasphemy against the Holy Spirit. It's not known exactly what he means by this. It could be that the only sin that can't be forgiven is the one that cuts you off from the source of forgiveness, the Holy Spirit.

Mark then brings Jesus' family back into the picture. They are not presented in a critical light but are just trying to see him. This gives Jesus the opportunity to point out that family for him is not based on blood.

PLANNING TO BE A CATHOLIC TEACHER

These Pastoral References are essential, if you are to teach in the Catholic Board. The reference asks the Parish Priest to attest to the practice of the Catholic Faith of the candidate. It is very important that those who seek a reference must:

- a. be a registered member of Our Lady of the Assumption Church (lives in our boundary).
- b.attend the Mass regularly.
- c.participate in the sacramental and pastoral life of the Church community (e.g. are you a lector, involved in the Youth Group, Children's Liturgy of the Word, etc.),
- d.be in good canonical standing within the Church
- e.have an attitude and disposition to serve Catholic Education positively.

It is essential that I be able to speak to all of these areas, and so if I can't, then I will not be compelled to complete any Pastoral Reference Forms simply because you approach me. We need in our schools, teachers who take seriously their faith. Teachers, who participate in it, celebrate it, and are willing to be able to transmit that to their students. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor at least 8 months before seeking a reference letter. Thank you.
