Reflection: The Gift of Peace and the Indwelling Spirit



In the Gospel for the Sixth Sunday of Easter (Cycle C), Jesus speaks words of comfort to His disciples, saying: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you." (John 14:27)

This passage is set within the context of the Last Supper, where Jesus prepares His followers for the challenges and uncertainties ahead. The peace He promises is not the absence of conflict or difficulty but an inner calm rooted in faith and trust in God. It is a

peace that the world cannot offer because it flows from a relationship with Christ and the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

In today's world, where anxiety and fear often prevail, this message is profoundly relevant. Jesus reassures us that even in the midst of trials, His peace remains steadfast. It is not dependent on external circumstances but on the presence of God within us.

Furthermore, Jesus promises the **Holy Spirit** as an Advocate and Teacher who will remind us of His words and guide us in truth. This promise highlights the ongoing presence of Christ in the life of believers. The Spirit equips us to face challenges with courage, wisdom, and the assurance that we are never alone.

Living the Gospel Message:

- **Seek Inner Peace:** Take moments each day to invite God's peace into your heart through prayer and meditation.
- **Trust in the Spirit's Guidance:** Be open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit, especially when making difficult decisions.
- **Be a Peacemaker:** As recipients of Christ's peace, we are called to be instruments of peace in our families, communities, and the world.

As we journey through this Easter season, let us hold onto the gift of peace that Jesus offers and lean on the Spirit who empowers us to live as His witnesses.
