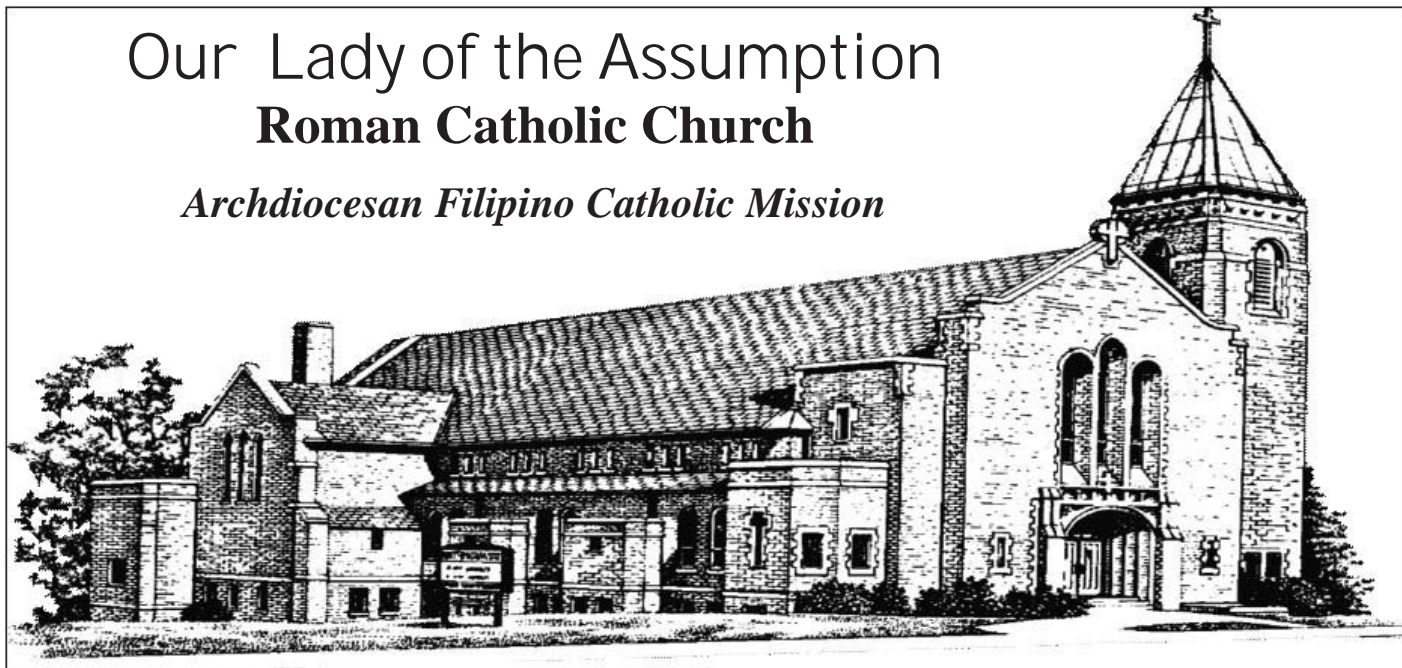

## Reflection for the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul

“Upon this rock I will build my Church...” (Matthew 16:18)



Today, we celebrate two pillars of the Church: **Saint Peter** and **Saint Paul**—very different men, united by their love for Christ and their total commitment to the Gospel.

**Peter**, the humble fisherman, was chosen by Jesus to be the rock upon which the Church would be built. Despite his impulsiveness and even his denial of Christ, Peter was forgiven and strengthened by the

Lord. His journey is a powerful reminder that God does not call the perfect—He perfects those He calls. Peter teaches us about **faith, humility, and leadership** in service of Christ.

**Paul**, on the other hand, was once a zealous persecutor of Christians. But his dramatic conversion on the road to Damascus transformed him into one of the greatest evangelizers in history. Paul’s life proclaims the truth that **no one is beyond the reach of God’s grace**, and that God’s plan can completely transform even the hardest of hearts.

Together, Peter and Paul represent the **unity and mission of the Church**: Peter, the symbol of stability and structure, and Paul, the symbol of missionary zeal and outreach. Their martyrdom in Rome is a testament to their unwavering love for Christ and His Church.

As we reflect on their lives, we are invited to ask ourselves:

- Do I have the **faith of Peter**, trusting Jesus even after I fall?
- Do I have the **passion of Paul**, proclaiming the Gospel without fear?
- Am I building up the Church like they did—with my prayers, my witness, and my daily service?

Let us pray today for **courage and conviction** in our Christian journey. May Saints Peter and Paul inspire us to live boldly for Christ, to proclaim Him in word and action, and to trust in His mercy no matter our past. *Saint Peter and Saint Paul, pray for us!*

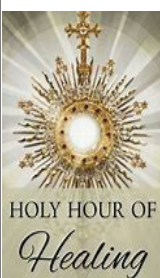

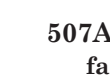
